LEED CRITERIA

RACO ALUMINUM FRAME/DOOR

MATERIALS & RESOURCES

MR 3.1

Materials Reuse – To reuse building materials and products to reduce demand for virgin materials and reduce waste, thereby lessening impacts associated with the extraction and processing of virgin resources.

RACO frames are screw or clip installed over drywall, allowing for removal and reinstallation. RACO frames are 100% reusable.

MR 4

Recycled Content – To increase demand for building products that incorporate recycled content materials, thereby reducing impacts resulting from extraction and processing of virgin materials.

RACO frames are manufactured from aluminum billet that is comprised of minimum 30% Post Consumer scrap and 48% Pre-Consumer scrap.

MR 5

Regional Materials – To increase demand for building materials and products that are extracted and manufactured within the region, thereby supporting the regional economy and reducing the environmental impacts resulting from transportation.
